Local authorities are uniquely positioned to address essential issues like housing, education, and public health, fostering inclusive societies and ensuring no one is left behind... The program also includes insights from the SERI and EU-Horizon "LEGITIMULT" research project, addressing crisis governance and the challenges of maintaining legitimacy and trust in multilevel systems.

Taught by staff from the University of Fribourg and international experts, this course offers a multidisciplinary approach with a mix of theoretical and practical methods, enabling participants to find solutions to pressing global challenges.


