Grants for the academic year 2025/2026

Thanks to the generous donation of the *Claudine and Hans-Heiner Zaeslin-Bustany-Foundation*, the Faculty of law may offer grants to the students from Fribourg who will study at the CTLS in the academic year 2025/2026.

The **criteria** to grant the financial support are the following:

- Outstanding results in the studies
- Excellent English proficiency

The **obligations** of the grant recipient are the following:

Each grant recipient undertakes

- To write a report for the Foundation's attention,
- To participate in a meeting bringing together the recipients of the grant, professors and representatives of the Foundation.

For the academic year 2025/2026, a maximum of 9 grants can be awarded. This grant cannot be cumulated with grants from other private foundations.

The grant is divided in two parts:

- Each student who is awarded a grant receives CHF 2'000.— (covering flights, transport costs and study materials) and is exempt from paying the additional CHF 1'500.— tuition. (The tuition fees of the University of Fribourg remain due as usual.)
- The second part of the grant goes to the Faculty of Law as a participation to the costs borne by the Faculty of Law as a member of the CTLS, to enable the students from Fribourg to participate to this programme.

How to apply for this grant?

- When applying for the CTLS, students wishing to apply for this grant must add in their motivation letter one specific paragraph stating why they apply for the grant.
- Adding a proof of English proficiency would be of an advantage (students who do not have a certificate such a TOEFL, IELTS or Cambridge, may take an English assessment at the Language Centre https://www.unifr.ch/studies/fr/assets/public/files/pdf/mob_out/english/EnglishAssessment OutgoingMobility.pdf)

When is the decision regarding the grant notified?

Students who have been awarded a scholarship will be notified by e-mail in May. They will receive a grant agreement to read, sign and return to the address ius-mobility@unifr.ch.

The scholarship will be paid by the end of June for a stay in the autumn semester and by the end of November for a stay in the spring semester.
