As non-local students to study in Hong Kong, they need to apply for a student visa. It takes about 4-6 weeks for the HK Immigration Department to process the application. The University can issue a sponsor letter to you in support of your visa application.

Conditions to apply:

The programme is open to the Master of Law students who are in their final year of study. The participating students from Fribourg shall meet one of the following English proficiency requirements:

- TOEFL: paper-based – 595 / internet-based 97
- IELTS 7.0

Application:

The application file, in English, is composed of:

- Pre-inscription form (for conventions)
- Curriculum Vitae with picture
- Statement of interest written in English
- Provisional list of the courses you wish to follow
- Photocopy of your passport
- Photocopy of all your academic results
- The application file must be sent to the Faculty of Law's Erasmus and International Relations Office, MIS 4060, Avenue de l'Europe 20, 1700 Fribourg.

Places: 2 places of one semester each per year, based on the principle of reciprocity.

Selection: At Fribourg University, a first selection will be made by the convention co-ordinator. A definitive selection will be made by Honk Kong City U.

Tuition fees: The students remain registered at the University of Fribourg during the abroad study period. They pay their regular tuitions fees at the University of Fribourg. They do not pay tuition fees at the host institution.

Recognition

The recognition principles decreed by the Equivalence Committee of the Faculty of Law apply for the recognition of the exams passed during the study period at City University Hong Kong.
