

CV Baptiste Brodard

Baptiste Brodard obtained his Ph.D. in religious studies at the Swiss Centre for Islam and Society (University of Fribourg, Switzerland) where he wrote a thesis on Islamic social work in response to social problems such as exclusion and identity-based conflicts in Western societies. The thesis' field is the interface between sociology and Islamic theology in the contemporary context. He is currently completing a postdoctoral study about autochthonous Muslim communities in Colombia and Mexico at the Universidad Veracruzana in Mexico. Along with his academic courses, he traveled to nearly 50 countries worldwide with the aim of meeting Muslim communities and scholars
